Hospital Quality & Efficiency Program (“HQEP”)

Remember BPCI Model 1—Gain Sharing? It’s back with a new flavor! A HQEP is a contractual agreement between a health system and a clinically integrated network to achieve quality improvements and cost reductions within the inpatient setting. These initiatives typically fall under the following categories:

- ⇒ Quality and safety outcomes (such as reduction in readmissions and hospital-acquired events)
- ⇒ Resource utilization (such as reduction in implant or supply unit pricing)
- ⇒ Operations (such as enhanced rounding and discharge planning processes)

Inspira’s HQEP program requires its participants to be members of Inspira Health Partners and is our first shared savings opportunity that **includes specialists in addition to primary care**. The HQEP program will include all commercial admissions (including managed Medicare and Medicaid). Inspira will be utilizing the savings methodology from New Jersey Hospital Association which was used in the prior Medicare program that ran from 4/1/13-3/31/16.

There are no financial risks for participation. Physicians must “opt in” to the program by completing the attached one-page election form. **Please return as soon as possible to ensure you take advantage of opportunities to share savings!** The Physician Handbook is also included for additional information.

Horizon Alliance Shared Savings Program

We are pleased to expand this shared savings program across the primary care practices in IHP. We have over 24,000 lives attributed to our practices. The Clinical Consensus Committee selected the quality metrics for this year’s program. We will be required to meet the 50th percentile in order to realize shared savings.

Measure	50 th Percentile
Breast cancer screening	71.17%
Colorectal cancer screening	60.07%
Screening for clinical depression	TBD
Adult BMI	77.05%
High blood pressure control	57.43%
Diabetes eye exam	49.82%
Diabetes HbA1c poor control (>9%)	33.57% (inverse measure)

Horizon Replaces Qualcare for Inspira Employee Insurance

Beginning April 1, 2018, Inspira will offer the Horizon Omnia plan to its members. This network includes three tiers of providers and facilities. The **Inspira Inner Circle** includes all providers within Inspira Health Partners and will allow our members to pay the least (and sometimes zero!) for using these providers. Omnia Tier 1 providers are also an affordable choice while Omnia Tier 2 providers are a higher cost. The member controls his or her cost by choosing where to seek care.
