Hospital Quality & Efficiency Program is Underway

We are pleased to announce that 142 physicians have enrolled in the HQEP program, formerly known as Gain Sharing. Credit will be given for cases on or after January 1, 2018. The first period runs from 1/1/18-6/30/18.

Quality metrics for the first period are attached. Specialty-specific quality metrics are being developed for future periods via Service Line Councils and work groups led by Steve Linn and Scott Wagner. Your input is welcome.

If you have not enrolled, it is not too late. Election forms received through June 30 will give credit for cases beginning July 1. There are no financial risks for participation. Physicians must "opt in" to the program by completing the attached one-page election form.



Horizon Alliance Program Citizenship Metrics

The IHP Finance Committee has been hard at work developing a distribution formula for 2018 for the Horizon Alliance shared savings program, which is distributed to primary care practices in IHP. It will go to the Board for final approval at its next meeting on May 30. Performance on quality and citizenship metrics will be part of this formula, and these metrics were approved by the Board on February 28. Quality measures have been previously communicated. Citizenship metrics are being announced for the first time. They include:

1. Practice must maintain lead physician and office manager contact information on file with IHP.
2. Practice must submit quality data to IHP per the specified schedule:
 - First quarter reports are due 4/15/18
 - Second quarter reports are due 7/15/18
 - Third quarter reports are due 10/15/18
 - Fourth quarter reports are due 1/15/19
