Displaying Supporting Facts

Definitions

Registry Supporting Facts: Tooltip displaying the reason why a person is included on the registry.

Measure Supporting Facts: Reason for what caused a measure's outcome. Indicators on each measure are displayed relevant to the supporting fact.

Steps

Registry Supporting Facts:

1. Find and display a person's summary.
2. From the Registries section, select the registry you wish to expand and display its measures.


Measure Supporting Facts
