Horizon Shared Savings Program Updates

2019 Physician Distribution Formula

The IHP Finance Committee has proposed a distribution formula for 2019 for the Horizon Alliance Shared Savings Program that has been approved by the Board. Components are as follows:

- Eligible funds will be prorated to primary care practices based on attributed lives
- Measure performance will condition payments to practices, with any dollars not earned used for future distribution pools
 - Quality measures condition 60% of the payment
 - Citizenship measures condition 20% of the payment
 - Utilization measures condition 20% of the payment

Details around measures in each category can be found on the website in addition to an illustrative example of payment calculations for two practice scenarios.

Quality Metrics—Cervical Cancer Screening

Cervical Cancer Screening has been added as a new metric in the adult program for 2019 as part of a mandatory screening bundle. All quality metrics and percentiles for 2019 can be found on the website.

Inclusions	Women between the ages of 21—64
Exclusions	1) Hospice services in 2019; 2) Total hysterectomy
Criteria for	1) Women 21—64 years of age who had cervical cytology performed every 3 years;
Satisfaction	2) Women 30—64 years of age who had cervical cytology / human papillomavirus (HPV) co-
	testing performed every 5 years
