Horizon Alliance Shared Savings Program

2019 Final Results

IHP's program had approximately 29,000 contact-attributed lives and 28,000 geographically-attributed lives for the 2019 shared savings performance year. Cost of care for contact-attributed lives ended at \$18 per member per month (PMPM) higher than target, while cost of care for geographically-attributed lives ended at \$12 PMPM lower than target. Net savings on the geographically-attributed population amounted to \$2.785 million, of which the physician pool (25%) is \$696,102. 2020 Physician Distribution Formula

The Board has approved the distribution formula for performance year 2020 as follows:

- Eligible funds will be prorated to primary care practices based on attributed lives
- Measure performance will condition payment to practices as follows, with any dollars not earned used for future distribution pools:
 - Quality measures condition 50% of the payment
 - Citizenship measures condition 25% of the payment
 - Utilization measures condition 25% of the payment

Aetna Health Shared Savings Program

2019 Final Results

IHP's program had approximately 14,000 attributed lives for the 2019 shared savings performance year. Cost of care for this population ended at \$18 PMPM higher than target, therefore no savings was achieved. The Aetna model compares IHP's performance to the market trend rather than to a benchmark based on IHP's own performance over time. The market for 2019 was defined as Cumberland, Salem, Gloucester, and Atlantic counties. In 2020, Inspira has elected to include Camden county in its market definition as well.

2020 Physician Distribution Formula

The Board has approved the distribution formula for performance year 2020 as follows:

- Eligible funds will be prorated to primary care practices based on attributed lives
- Measure performance will condition payment to practices as follows, with any dollars not earned re-distributed to practices who achieved 100% scores within the two categories below using a proration based on attributed lives:
 - Quality measures condition 75% of the payment
 - Citizenship measures condition 25% of the payment
