## COVID-19 Vaccine Availability

**Primary Care and Specialist Practices:** Inspira Health has COVID Vaccine Pop Up Tents located in the parking lots of Inspira Medical Centers Vineland and Mullica Hill. Members of the community are now able to walk up to the tent and receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine during the following times:

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday: 8am—6pm
- Wednesday: 7am—7pm
- Saturday: 9am—1pm

Inspira Health will also be offering walk-up vaccines for anyone interested as follows:

- Cumberland Regional High School on Thursday, May 6th from 1pm - 5pm
- Millville High School on Tuesday, May 11th from 2pm - 5pm

Members of the community under the age of 18 must have a form of ID that shows their date of birth. They must be accompanied by a parent/guardian who is authorized to sign an informed consent for the minor's vaccination. Please share this information with your patients, all are welcome!

## New! Horizon Dispute Process

**Primary Care Practices:** Horizon made changes to the attribution methodology and dispute process for 2021. Horizon members can only be disputed if they meet one of the following criteria: provider saw patient while covering for another practice, patient is deceased, or patient is discharged from the practice. The 'discharge from practice' option can be used for the following reasons: refusal to vaccinate, lawsuit threats, physical threats, or inappropriate behavior to staff. If patients meet the dispute criteria, practices should send their dispute requests to IHP by uploading patient information to Inspira's sFTP site. ## Bayada at Inspira Referral Reminder

**Primary Care and Specialist Practices:** Home care services can mitigate safety concerns and hospital re-admissions by providing patients with support in the home environment. It is imperative that home care orders are filled out accurately and in their entirety, so services are not delayed. When placing a home care order, providers should avoid using the ineligible primary diagnoses outlined in the attached document. Practices should also include the patient's face sheet, medications, and last office visit note with the order.
